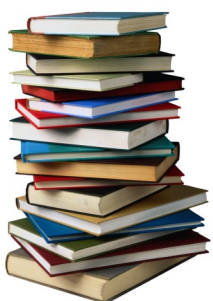

How to Return Books

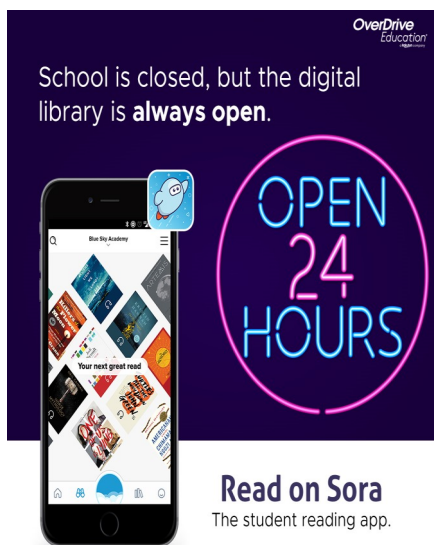
You can return books to the bin outside the front doors of the school M-F from 8:30am-1:00pm.

SORA App– For District & County Library Books



- 1- Install the Sora app from the Apple App Store or Google Play Store, or go to soraapp.com
 - 2- In Sora, find your school [Tolman Elementary](#)
 - 3- Sign in: Students sign in using their **full email**—
Example: 18adavis@go.dsdmail.net
Password: use the same **# password** for school accounts. Example: [7654321](#)
 - 4- Click on the Explore tab and borrow a book. It will open automatically.
To close tap at the top of screen.
 - 5- Click on the Shelf to see all your books
