## Minutes of the Community Council Meeting

October 6, 2021

- Item 1 Mr. Hammerschmidt invited each community council member to introduce themselves and tell their association with the school.
- Item 2 Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.
- Item 3 Community Council Training Video, created by the State Board of Education, was viewed by Council Members.
- Item 4 Principal Hammerschmidt reported on the proposed 2021-2022 School Improvement Plan.

**Reading Goal** - Show a 4% increase (or more) of students with typical or greater growth in Reading Skills. This will be measured by comparing the MOY (middle of year) 2021 to the MOY of 2022 using Acadience Benchmark tests.

Math Goal - 70% of our 3-6<sup>th</sup> grade students will score proficiently on a preselected grade level math benchmark (practice) test.

SEL Goal - Improve school climate by implementing SEL instruction.

Reading, Writing, Math, and Science Goal - At least 2% student growth in proficiency from the previous end of the year RISE tests.

Item 5 Principal Hammerschmidt reported on the Trust lands Funding.

Mr. Hammerschmidt reported on the allocated budget that comes from the Trust Land Funds, the small carry over from last year, and how the funds will be spent this correct year. There is a small surplus that is set aside for unforeseen expenses during the year.

Due to Covid Concerns, the school community activities, such as Halloween Costume Parade, Literacy Night and Stem Night will canceled for this year. The Halloween Carnival will be held outside. Parent/Teacher/Student Conferences will be conducted using Zoom unless in person meetings are needed.
